Covid Vaccines

Clinics are now running at Rosebank Surgery on Saturdays so that they do not have a negative impact on our regular surgeries. Currently vaccinations are being offered to over 75s and immunosuppressed patients (Spring Booster) and the first vaccine for children aged 5-11 years. We also welcome first timers! Invitations have been sent out to all those who are eligible, but "Walk-ins" are also encouraged.

FACT: There have been approximately 100 Walk-ins per session!

Rosebank Hub

The Hub team consists of a group of care coordinators, GPs, ANPs, social prescribers and pharmacists, all working together to ensure the patients journey through primary care is as efficient and seamless as possible.

The Hub aims to improve continuity of care for patients. Did you know that:

- 59% of appointments are dealt with in the Hub on the day, either Face to Face,
 via text, or by a phone call from a GP
- 80% of appointments are now Face to Face
- 85% of urgent problems are seen on the same day
- The number of phone calls into the surgery in March was 29,640
- The number of eConsults into the surgery in March was 3797
- In the first quarter of 2022 we provided 71,017 appointments!

Please remember that if your GP requests a blood (or any other) test, you may not be offered a Face to Face appointment until the results are available.

All patients who would prefer to see a GP in person will be offered a Face to Face appointment at the earliest opportunity

Your Telephone Consultation

Some ailments are much better dealt with over the phone:

- The patient does not have to leave the comfort of their own home to visit the surgery when they are feeling unwell
- Less chance of spreading nasty bugs and viruses and less chance of picking something up!
- GPs can assess more patients and diagnose more quickly
- Sometimes the GP might ask you to send a photo of your ailment if you have access to a suitable camera. This is completely confidential.
- Sometimes your GP may be able to diagnose your ailment over the phone and arrange for suitable treatment more quickly
- Certain things always need a Face to Face appointment; lumps, bumps, heart, neurological concerns, and these will be arranged as soon as possible
