- FIT Test (i.e. stool sample)

- Offered to women between 25-64 years old
- Invited every 3 or 5 years
- Cervical Smear

Breast Cancer



- Offered to women between 50-71 years old
- Invited every 3 years
- Mammogram (X-Ray)
